



Meal Distribution effective January 4, 2021

We are excited to announce that school meals will be provided at no charge to all students through the USDA emergency feeding programs. Meals, whether picked up at a designated location, or eaten in the buildings, are included with the free meal program.

Who is eligible for the school meal program?

Children aged 1-18 during the duration of the free meal program through the USDA.

Meals are free of charge for 2020-21

Eligible families may also be eligible for Pandemic-Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) with a completed application. Please find more information [HERE](#). If meals are picked up at more than 1 site, the cost of the second meal is \$2.40 for breakfast and \$4.15 for lunch for all students.

What meals will be provided?

Meals will include breakfast and lunch. Meals will be provided with preparation and heating instructions.
